After a traumatic tragedy when she was 11 years old, which occurred to some close family friends resulting in 4 people being shot and two being murdered, Victoria became interested in the minds of serial killers. "I read books, newspapers and watched TV documentaries on this dark subject matter ever since our friends were murdered."

"Since coming to America, I have hosted various shows and

commercials. A production company that I had worked with before asked if I'd be interested to host a new pilot/show on serial killers! I jumped at the chance and said, heck I'll do more than host it, I want to interview the serial killer, too! They told me to go and find a suitable subject which was hard work."

"Finally, I found Wayne Adam Ford in San Bernardino County jail, who was temporarily housed there while going through trial, before ending up on Death Row where he is now. I went to the trial and also interviewed him on a daily basis. He built trust in me and I made a full length documentary on his life and crimes."

From there Victoria decided to create more shows on this subject and now has
